REFERRAL SERVICES (in details)

Any covered Medical, Surgical, Paediatrics, Obstetrics & Gynaecology healthcare services that cannot be undertaken at the primary care level should be referred to the secondary level of care and covered services that cannot be undertaken at the secondary level of care level can be referred to the tertiary level of care. Covered services under Psychiatry, Ophthalmology, Dental, Physiotherapy, ENT, Laboratory, Radiology services that cannot be performed at any provider level should be referred appropriately.

Well Baby Clinic; Immunization (according to National Primary Healthcare

Development Agency - NPHCDA guidelines); Child Nutrition Assessment, Growth

Monitoring and Promotion, Preventing Malnutrition; Essential Nutrition Actions;

Growth Chart; Micronutrient Supplementation - Vitamin A, Iron, Iodine, Zinc; Integrated Management of Neonatal and Childhood Illness (IMNCI) using IMNCI protocol; Exclusive breast feeding

Congenital anomalies; childhood tumours; treatment and procedures for conditions or diagnosis not listed under the benefit package; Injuries resulting from natural disasters, e.g. earthquakes, landslides; Conflicts, social unrest, riots, wars; injuries arising from extreme sports, e.g. car racing, horse racing, polo, mountaineering, boxing, wrestling, etc.; epidemics overwhelming the primary healthcare centre; autoimmune disorders; drug abuse/addiction; domiciliary visit; surgical procedures not listed; optical care & dental care not listed; post mortem examination and embalming
